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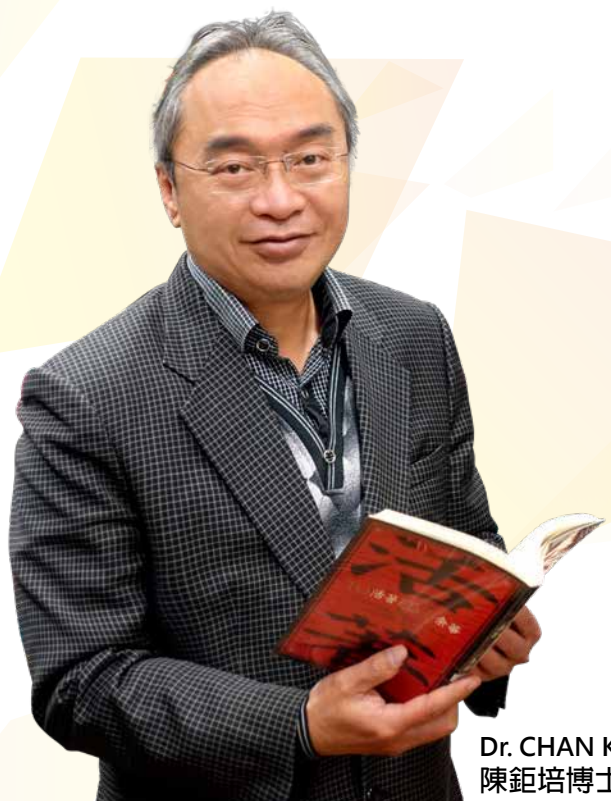
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Principal's Message

校長的話

Delia GP has become an IB World School. I recall the next day after we got the news of our accreditation, a student walked up to me with a lovely smile and said, “You have accomplished your dream, congratulations!” I was a bit shocked and my instinct asked me to think of which dream she was referring to. I remembered she was one of the student representatives interviewed by the IB inspectors a while ago. By then I was aware of what she had actually meant.

A lot of memories ran through my head when someone like this little girl said that my dream had come true.

Eight years ago, when I transformed myself from a Broadwayer into a GleePather, it seemed to me that a lot of things had changed. My desk changed; the school changed; the teachers changed; the students

changed. But one thing stayed the same, and it is still the same up to this moment: my belief in education. To be more specific: my belief in multicultural education.

Nineteen years ago, when I was granted an opportunity to work with children of different ethnicities in Delia Broadway, I tried to adjust myself. Based on a teacher’s instinct, I read several books. I tried to find ways to get along better with my students, looked for ideal models so that the students with me could benefit the most. James Banks’s multicultural education appealed to me the most. After recognizing the methodologies available, we implemented them. At the same time, the enrolment of ethnic minorities in Broadway increased. Starting with the number of 14 students when I first joined the school, 11 years later when I left, there were more than 800 students from different multicultural backgrounds.

In 2011 I brought nothing from Broadway to Glee Path but my belief in multicultural education. Since the first day I came to Delia GP, I was very much conscious of the “mistakes” I had made, especially the overwhelming composition of non-Chinese-speaking population in the school. I was aware of this because this situation jeopardized the implementation of a multicultural education. The lack of balance in the ethno-cultural composition of Broadway was not ideal for the provision of a bilingual environment for children to develop their language skills, specifically in their second language.

That was why in Delia GP, we implemented a new initiative in Hong Kong called the Immersion Pilot Scheme. We also started a teaching pedagogy called Two-Way Immersion in different subjects. We launched

an interesting co-curricular activity called GP Family. We regularly promoted our initiatives—and the beliefs underpinning them—to parents, students, and even the alumni through 凝融, a school magazine for all stakeholders.

Seeing the increasing number of students in Delia GP, the senior management was happy. But I was worried about the lack of balance in the composition of the two speaking groups in school that seemed to grow more disproportionate day after day.

I had to admit that Two-Way Immersion, the core of our multicultural education, is too distant a concept for the general public to understand, especially when it is translated into Chinese as 雙語雙向沉浸課程. In the summer of 2016, a series of concerted meetings were held among all the teachers

in Delia GP and we decided on several things. Our school’s core value “Come to learn, Go to learn” was born. At the same time, we identified our next goal, which was to become authorized to offer the IB, an international program centered on international mindedness, aimed at bringing pupils from different ethnicities together. More than this, the IB would be a much easier concept than Two-Way Immersion for the general public to understand in terms of what kind of education we provide.

We achieved the IB dream together with a team of visionary and committed teaching

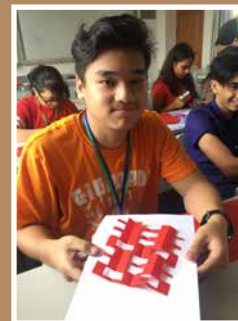

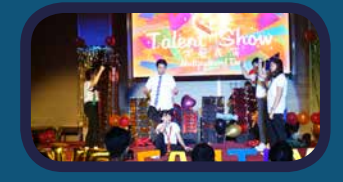
Multicultural Day

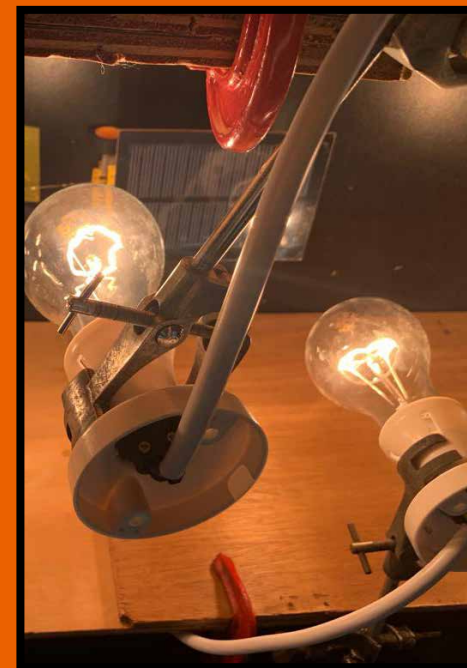
6C Mujtaba-Amjad

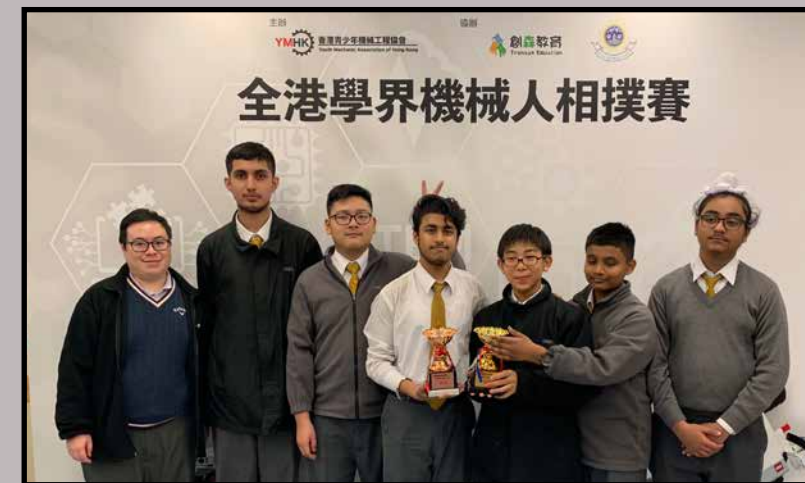

Escape if you can 逃脫遊戲



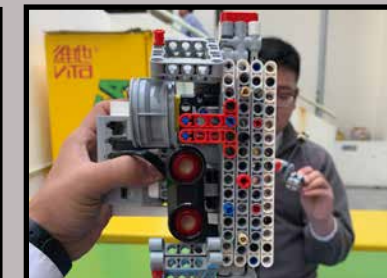
