很多人的夢想都會隨著時間而有所改變，我亦然。小時候，我的夢想是要成為一位警察。當時，投考警察必須要有良好體能、優良成績及具有冷靜的處事能力。當然，亦隱藏著很多鮮為人知的「潛規則」。

大學畢業後，我嘗試投考警察，可惜無功而還，失敗收場。「阿 Q 精神」自我安慰：大概是因為年少氣盛，人生閱歷不足使然。我沒有因此而放棄，幾年後，我再次投考，希望憑著幾年的工作經驗成功突圍。而且，那是最後的一次機會，因為當時投考警察的年齡必須在三十歲以下。

「機會是留給有準備的人」，為了應付這次考試，我用了超過半年的時間去操練體能，風雨不改，我深信自己的體能並不遜於年輕的一群。再者，為了在討論環節中有突出表現，我專心鑽研本地和全球的社會時事議題，務求能提出獨特見解，脫穎而出。考核還包括參加一個為期三天的密集式訓練營，參加者須要熟習警察日常工作，例如怎樣處理交通意外、社會騷亂、自然災害等突發事故。

最終，我的「夢想」落空了。我收到警局寄來的不取錄通知書，信中沒有提及落選原因。一種莫名其妙的無力感由此而生，從未嚐過如此滋味。我的童年夢想就給這封信摧毀了……

就在我的夢想被殘酷現實摧毀的同一年，

我的女兒出生了，她的到來仿如晨光，為我的生命帶來不一樣的色彩，這種感覺實在難以言喻，也許要當上父親或母親的你才會明白。我很享受跟她一起的時光，最喜歡的當然是把她抱在懷中，聽到她的心跳聲，生命實在太奇妙！我幾乎用盡所有時間和精力去照顧這個小寶貝，警察落選一事，我早已拋諸腦後。

一年後，我報讀了一個為期兩年的教育管理課程。再過兩年，家中又多添了一位成員——我的小女兒。在照顧女兒的同時，我繼續完成課程，喜出望外的是我竟以優異成績畢業。於是，我決定繼續攻讀博士學位。短短四年間，我的人生起了重大的變化，我被學校委任到三間不同的學校。不同的

工作崗位，讓我在處事及人際關係上成熟了不少，當然還有與一班並肩作戰的工作伙伴一起跨過一個又一個的難關。另一「夢想」亦出現了，讓我更清楚明白自己該走的路。

假若我的童年夢想落空時，我不敢面對失敗、失去鬥志，我的人生會有這樣的改變嗎？

如果我的人生路上遇不到那些默默支持我的人（尤其是我的妻子，過往很少提及她），我的人生會有這樣的改變嗎？

假如我遇到困難時，我選擇逃避，我的人生會有這樣的改變嗎？

在艱難的日子，我學會以積極樂觀的

態度去面對，也學會凡事感恩，更學會勇於作出嘗試及改變，「窮則變，變則通」，世間哪有難事？

親愛的吉利徑人、今年的中六畢業生，2019/2020 是充滿荊棘的一年，天災人禍接連發生。「行到水窮處，坐看雲起時。」在生命裡，不論是學業、家庭、工作或是與朋友相處，都總是充滿挑戰。但我們總不能逃避這些困難。有時我們以為身處絕境中，無路可走，這時候不妨抬頭向天一望，深深吸一口氣，咬緊牙關，一定開闢出一條康莊大道！

For the F.2 English activity, we invited the amazing Mr. Zohab Khan, who is not only a slam poet but also a hip-hop musician and an educator, to give a performance and a talk. 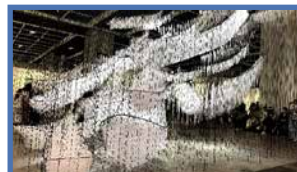
Exhibition Visit of the Art Basel in Hong Kong

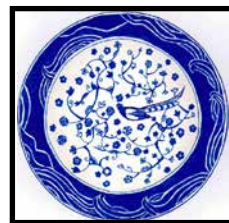
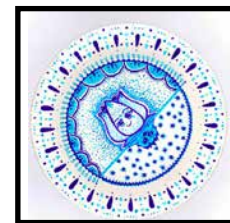
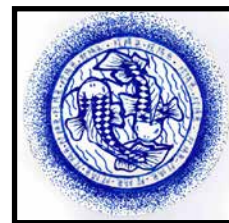
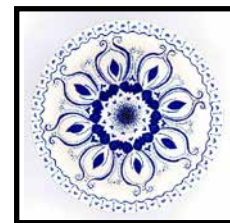
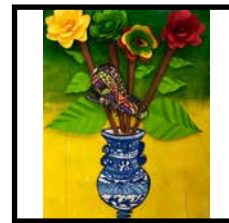
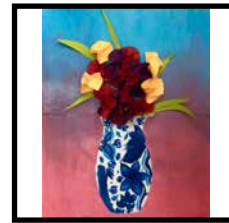
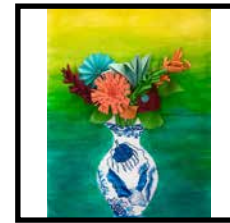
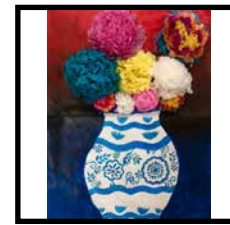
3B MACDONALD WARISARA ANDRIA

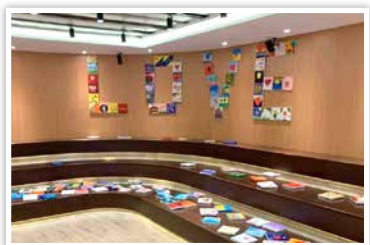
GP Family Art Jam

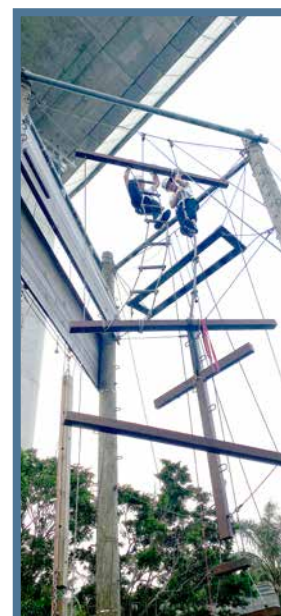
Joint-School Students' Welfare Association Leadership Training Day

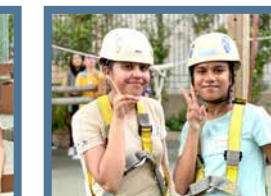

Dare Buddies「敢·想·敢·做」

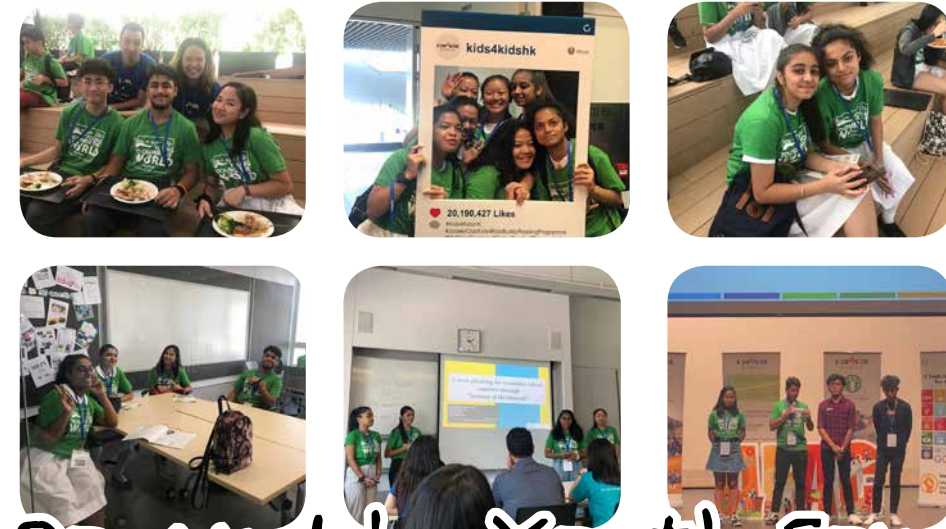

3C KAUR MAHEKDEEP

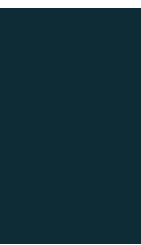
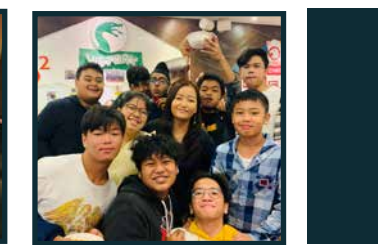

4C RANA SIRISHAK

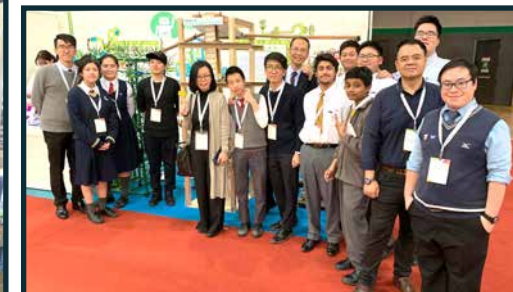
